## Abstract on the Topic of the Presentation

Mobile as a technology will be a disruptive force for the next decade; and enterprise mobility programs will be fundamental for organizations to remain relevant. Mobile security is tightly linked to enterprise mobility and, to large extent, depends on the maturity of the enterprise mobility strategy and security framework.

Though mobile platforms have been designed with security in mind, the typical enterprise mobile environment comprises of mobile devices, platforms, client-side and server-side applications, networks, content, and transactions. An exploitable vulnerability in any of them can become an attack vector. A mobile security framework should protect all elements of the mobile environment.

The presentation will cover a typical enterprise mobility security framework and components of the enterprise mobility strategy.
